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

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# FROM SOUTH KOREA WITH LOVE!

# The World Premiere of The Square, the animated romantic masterpiece that will close the Far East Film Festival 27.

### Two more World Premieres added to the line-up: the restored version of cult movie *The System* and from Indonesia, horror movie *Mad of Madness*.

UDINE – It will be a wonderful little **animated masterpiece** – South Korean love story **The Square** – that officially closes the **Far East Film Festival 27**. A true immersion in poetry and beauty which is coming to Udine for its **world premiere**, and which will happily play counterpoint to the second title of the Closing Night: **Ya Boy Kongming! The Movie**, an irresistible and anarchic musical *divertissement* which is presented out of competition. But the news doesn't end with the reveal of the title that during the press conference still bore the label "surprise film"...

Two more world premieres have in fact been **added to the line-up**: the restored version of gritty 1979 Hong Kong cult movie *The System*, directed by Peter Yung and absolutely impossible to find until today, and Indonesian horror movie *Mad of Madness*, where fear and politics and society look one another square in the face. Two **world premieres** that, obviously, change **all the numbers** of **FEFF 27**: the total number of titles goes from 75 to 77, the number of countries participating, including Indonesia, rises to 12, the world premieres become 8, the international premieres 16, the European premieres 20 and the Italian premieres 19. And finally, the number of titles in competition goes up to 49.

Speaking of numbers, let's also highlight the presence of **two short films**, *Once Upon a Time There Was a Mountain* and *Sweet*, *Sour, Bitter...*, both made in Hong Kong and both coming out of Camp that took place in Macau in 2024 (the Asian Film Awards Academy International Film Camp), plus we certainly mustn't forget the **12 titles** that make up this year's highly anticipated retrospective: *Yōkai and Other Monsters: from Asian Folklore to Cinema* (the screenings will be held at the Visionario). And one of the major events of this edition will also be dedicated to the Japanese mythological creatures known as *Yōkai*.

100 original pages of artwork, magazines, books, video documents and critical texts that reconstruct the universe of **legendary** *mangaka* **Shigeru Mizuki**: we're talking about *Mondo Mizuki, Mondo Yokai*, the exhibition curated by Canicola, Vincenzo Filosa and Mizuki Productions which from 26 April to 30 August will bring the creative universe of this giant to the "Casa Cavazzini" Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art in Udine. Organised on the occasion of **FEFF 27**, *Mondo Mizuki, Mondo Yokai* is the first anthological event in Italy and the second in Europe to celebrate one of the most important protagonists of this Japanese art.

UDINE – If Asia is a galaxy, contemporary Asia is the planet upon which the **Far East Film Festival of Udine** rests its eyes – eyes that are as curious as they are enamoured. That's what it's been doing ever since its **very first edition in 1999**, and now that it's about to write the **27<sup>th</sup> chapter** of its long history, its eyes are looking more intensely than ever. And as well as being curious and enamoured, its eyes are also deeply attentive to the colours, nuances and pressures of current events. Even more than being a **journey** and an **accumulation of narratives**, the **FEFF** is a **gaze** - a gaze that graphic designer Roberto Rosolin has crystallised in the new official image that the festival will multiply through the **thematic trajectories** of the new line-up.

**75 titles** (48 in competition, 27 out of competition) from **11 countries**. More precisely, **7 world premieres**, **15 international premieres**, **20 European premieres** and **19 Italian premieres**. A **vast selection of popular cinema**, which obviously also includes auteur movies and tributes to the past, through which to **observe today's Asia and its narrative close-up**. Very close-up. Never before, in fact, has popular cinema seemed so interested in **speaking about time and society** - without giving up its popular, mainstream and commercial vocation, but also without skimping on the food for thought. Food for thought that is sometimes trenchant. And from this point of view, the **box office of mainland China** certainly represents an emblematic case.

Chinese viewers loved **Upstream**, which reflects upon the phenomenon of the **gig economy** (after being fired, its protagonist tries to get by with temporary work), and they loved **FEFF 27's opening film**: **Green Wave**, which reflects on the phenomenon of **tangping** (young people metaphorically "lying down" in rejection of the ultra-competitive logics of career and success). And what is there to say about **Her Story** and **Like a Rolling Stone**? Two directors, **Yihui Shao** and **Yin Lichuan**, with two great stories of **gender equality**. Stories that use different languages – the language of comedy and the language of the biographical journey - to address the crux of the issue of **female emancipation**: the right of women to decide for themselves, to rebel, and to fly with their own wings.

Held in Udine at the historic headquarters of the **Teatro Nuovo** theatre and in the spaces of the **Visionario** cinema, **FEFF 27** will close with a **surprise film** which is already destined to join the **grand family of Far East cult movies**: we're talking about the irresistible and highly anticipated **Ya Boy Kongming! The Movie**, the live-action adaptation of a famous manga set during the **Music Battle Awards 2025**, a contest where Japanese record labels battle one another fiercely. It's hard to imagine a film which is more anarchic, or more allergic to being classified!

From 24 April to 2 May the festival will offer a 9-day full immersion (with screenings from morning to night, talks, a daily live press review and stars walking the red carpet, without obviously forgetting the Focus Asia industry section, the journalistic itineraries of Bambù and the educational focus of the FEFF Campus) and will transform the heart of the city into a vibrant Asian Zone (there are over 100 Far East Film Events scheduled). A true celebration of cinema which is reflected in the words of the main sponsors, Credifriuli and Amga Energia & Servizi - Commercial brand of the Hera Group.

"For us," says **Luciano Sartoretti**, President of **Credifriuli**, "supporting the Far East Film Festival for the twelfth year in a row is not simply a question of tradition, but one of identity. We are a bank which is rooted in the local area and made up of people who believe in the value of culture and its power to create connections. The **FEFF** is much more than a festival: it's a bridge between Friuli and the world, just as we try to be for our community. Supporting events like this means investing in something that enriches all of us, and we will continue to do so with the same enthusiasm as always."

The **FEFF** has the ability to anticipate cultural trends and has continued to attract the interest of the public for 27 years now. Its pioneering vision, open to the world and to new influences, reflects the values of innovation, sustainability and roots in the local area that are at the heart of the Hera Group's mission."

#### **SYLVIA CHANG: A QUEEN IN UDINE**

In 2024 a king by the name of **Zhang Yimou** took the stage of the Teatro Nuovo and the **FEFF** awarded him the **Golden Mulberry for Lifetime Achievement Award**. This year, on the same stage, a queen will be collecting the **Golden Mulberry for Lifetime Achievement Award**: **Sylvia Chang**. Actress, singer, director, screenwriter, producer and radio DJ. If it weren't so overused, the word "icon" would be perfect for her - but to be honest, no word can really capture her greatness! **FEFF 27** will allow visitors to admire the **diva of yesterday**, with **Tsui Hark**'s legendary **Shanghai Blues** (one of the gems of the restored classics section), and the **diva of today**, with splendid family drama **Daughter**.

#### THE CINEMATIC GEOGRAPHY OF FEFF 27

As we wrote at the beginning when talking about **mainland China**, never before has **popular Asian cinema** seemed so interested in telling stories of **time and society**, and this powerful **contemporary impulse** is the common thread that connects cities, metropolises and nations on the map of Asia, outlining the **cinematic geography** of **FEFF 27**. If **mainland China** talks to us about the **gig economy**, *tangping* and gender equality, Japan entrusts the Lynchian *Teki Cometh* with one of the most thorny and debated topics: **the ageing population**. A theme which authors and directors in its homeland have been tackling for some years now (remember *Plan 75*?). If **South Korea** sides with those left on the margins (there are a thousand ways to be discriminated against and to become an outsider, as titles like *Hear Me* or *Love in the Big City* remind us), the **Philippines** pulls out *Sunshine* and points the finger at the **criminalisation of abortion**: a dramatic descent into the darkness of Manila for one of the most powerful, and most beautiful, titles of this edition. And finally, if living in the **post-truth millennium** forces us to try and distinguish every day between **what is authentic and what is not**, from Thailand comes incredible debut film *The Stone* where - as in the case of the terracotta bowl around which the opening film *Green Wave* unfolds - concepts of "**true**" and "**false**" become absolutely tangible. The Thais believe that amulets bring good luck and protection: this is why they are more precious than gold and diamonds and why the market is dominated by violent power struggles...

#### MONDO MIZUKI, MONDO YOKAI

100 original pages of artwork, magazines, books, video documents and critical texts to reconstruct the **universe of legendary** *mangaka* **Shigeru Mizuki**: we're talking about *Mondo Mizuki, Mondo Yokai*, the exhibition curated by Canicola, Vincenzo Filosa and Mizuki Productions which from the 26<sup>th</sup> of April to the 30<sup>th</sup> of August will bring the creative universe of a true giant of the manga form to the "Casa Cavazzini" Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art in Udine. A giant who specialised in stories about *Yokai*, the creatures of Japanese mythology. Organised on the occasion of **FEFF 27**, *Mondo Mizuki, Mondo Yokai* is the first anthological event in Italy and the second in **Europe** to celebrate one of the major protagonists of this Japanese art.

#### A MONSTER OF A RETROSPECTIVE!

Yokai also feature in this year's **retrospective** (and **publication**): Yokai and Other Monsters: From Asian Folklore to Cinema. 12 films that will fill the FEFF 27 screens with bizarre and disturbing "presences"! Japanese Yokai (sometimes very dangerous, like the fearsome Snow Woman) will alternate with Thailand's terrifying Krasue (flying head) and the almost analogous Mananang-gal from the Philippines, along with the leaping Chinese vampire known as the Jiangshi who is kept at bay not by garlic but... by rice. In short, a true embarrassment of riches to choose from. If Western horror cinema has always been nourished by folklore beliefs dating right back to Count Dracula, this retrospective intends to document how Asian horror-fantasy cinema has always plundered its own folklore, celebrating and redefining its own local monsters.

#### **RESTORED CLASSICS**

A special mention goes to the **restored classics** section, which is packed with truly unmissable movies: from the European premiere of *Barking Dogs Never Bite*, the explosive directorial debut of Oscar winner **Bong Joon-ho**, and Filipino evergreen *Bona* by Lino Brocka, right up to Johnnie To's absolute masterpiece *PTU*. The FEFF has also



renewed its collaboration with the **Taipei Archive** (**Taiwan Film and Audiovisual Institute**) and will be presenting a three-film tribute to director **Pai Ching-jui** who, in 1961, managed to realise his dream and enrolled at the **Centro Sperimentale di Cinematografia in Rome** where he studied Italian cinema and, in particular, neorealism.

#### **FEFF ONLINE**

Supported as always by MYmovies, this year's **FEFF** will also offer a priceless **selection of titles online** for the entire duration of the festival: **22** films that Asian distribution houses have made available for streaming.

#### THE JURY IS IN

If, as always, it is the public and the public alone who decide the three films that will climb the podium of the Far East Film Festival 27 to claim the the Golden Mulberry, the Silver Mulberry and the Crystal Mulberry, it will instead be the job of the two specialised juries to assign the White Mulberry for Best First Film and the Mulberry for Best Screenplay: these are, respectively, Megumi (actress, singer, influencer), Kim Yutani (programmer of the Sundance Film Festival) and Sakoda Shinji (international film representative), and three jurors from the "Sergio Amidei" Gorizia International Award for Best Screenplay: screenwriter Massimo Gaudioso, screenwriter Silvia D'Amico and director Francesco Munzi.

#### **FEFF GOES GREEN**

For a genuine **reduction of its environmental impact**, the **FEFF** last year started a **process of calculating its carbon footprint** in collaboration with TEC4IFVG and eFrame within the European project Capacity2Transform. This effort is part of the broader objective of the Friuli Venezia Giulia Region to reach **carbon neutrality** by 2045.

Udine, March 25, 2025. 100 original works, many of which exhibited outside Japan for the first time, reproductions, magazines, books, video documents and critical texts to recreate the universe of Shigeru Mizuki, one of the greatest masters of Japanese manga. This is Mondo Mizuki, Mondo Yokai, the exhibition curated by Canicola and Vincenzo Filosa which, from the 26th of April to the 30th of August 2025, brings to Casa Cavazzini in Udine the creative universe of a Master without equal, a specialist in stories of yokai - the monstrous apparitions of Japanese mythology - and a scholar of the relative folklore, with all his unique and deeply personal style.

Organized on the occasion of **the twenty-seventh edition of the Far East Film Festival, Mondo Mizuki, Mondo Yokai** is the first **exhibition in Italy**, and the second in Europe after the solo exhibition in Angoulême in 2022, to celebrate one of the greatest authors of Japanese sequential art: an initiative that allows manga-lovers - and everyone else - to lose themselves in a world of unforgettable masterpieces.

On the occasion of the exhibition, Canicola is publishing II mondo delle fessure rotonde: the first anthology in the West to present previously unpublished comic stories together with autobiographical writings and reflections on tkaphe language of manga by Mizuki, published between 1966 and 1980 in the famous 'Garo' magazine, a reference point for the world of alternative manga, and a training ground for many experimental manga authors. The book is a tool for learning about creatures and legends of ancient times, which Mizuki translated into the depths of the great metropolises of modern Japan. Talking warts, ninja clones, waffling alchemists and flying capes populate these stories still unpublished outside Japan, presenting the Italian public with a glimpse into the mind and art of this unparalleled author.

The concept and realisation of Mondo Mizuki, Mondo Yokai are by the C.E.C. - Centro Espressioni Cinematografiche/Far East Film Festival (Udine) in agreement with Mizuki Pro (Japan) and with Canicola (Bologna).

In parallel with the exhibition, the Far East Film Festival 27 will dedicate a retrospective programme to the legendary creatures that populate Asian films, entitled Yokai and Other Monsters: From Asian Folklore to Cinema.

In summary, Focus Asia is not just a meeting point for film industries worldwide, it is a gateway for the films of the future. TIES THAT BIND is the leading training programme for European-Asian co-production and it is targeted at European & Asian producers focusing on feature fiction films project in development.

The selected producers work with **top-notch industry professionals from both continents**.

The rich programme of the plenary sessions for the TTB workshop is prepared in **collaboration with FOCUS ASIA** and it will feature sessions focused on:

- remake rights
- Al
- script development,
- co-production between Asia and Europe,
- co-productions case studies,
- public and private financing in the two regions,
- pitching and communication skills,
- marketing and distribution

The participants, consisting of **5 European** and **5 Asian producers** with feature fiction film projects, will be accompanied by **5 European professionals** interested in working with Asia, such as **sales agents**, **financiers**, **distributors**, **festival programmers**, **co-production market representatives**, or **European producers** who wish to focus on their career development.

Individual meetings with TTB experts will be moreover organised: script consultants Clare Downs (UK) will focus on developing their scripts and pitching consultant Sibylle Kurz (DE) will work on their presentation and communication skills.

For the very first time, Marketing and Focus Groups with AI will also be organized.

TTB graduates **Fran Borgia** (Akanga Film Asia ) and **Jonas Weydemann** (Weydemann Bros) will lead the group sessions dedicated to the selected feature film projects.

The participants will also have **individual meetings with key industry professionals at Focus Asia**, to foster new collaborations between European and Asian professionals.

#### **K-POP CONTEST**

Friday the 25th of April at 3:00 pm, Loggia di San Giovanni In collaboration with K-ble Jungle and Comicon

This year the Far East Film Festival introduces an explosive new event to its programme as it becomes an official stop of the K-Pop Dance Fight Fest.

K-pop (Korean Pop) is a musical genre born in South Korea which in recent years has taken Italy by storm, and this is an unmissable opportunity for all those fans who want to show their talent in front of a unique audience.

The Loggia di San Giovanni will become the stage where soloists and crews will challenge one another through dance, bringing the energy and spectacle of the K-Pop Dance Fight Fest to the heart of the FEFF. Soloists participating in the contest will have the opportunity to qualify for the grand final on the 21st of June at Comicon in Bergamo.

Up for grabs is funding to help with the trip to the final and exclusive FEFF 27 gadgets.

#### **COSPLAY CONTEST**

Thursday the 1st of May from 15.00, Loggia di San Giovanni

One of the most eagerly-anticipated events of the Far East Film Festival, The Cosplay Contest celebrates its 15th edition and once again transforms Udine into the backdrop for a spellbinding mix of characters from manga, anime, comics, cinema, music and video games.

This edition will be bursting with musical entertainment! The Players, a band from Friuli that has got us dancing to the most famous cartoon theme songs in previous years, will be returning, while the big news this year is the presence of Pietro Ubaldi, one of the most beloved voices in Italian dubbing, famous for having given life to iconic characters such as Captain Barbossa (Pirates of the Caribbean) and Doraemon. Accompanied by Stefano Bersola, Ubaldi will be performing a concert entitled "A journey of souls": an exciting immersion in the universe of theme songs and animated cinema through the melodies that have captivated entire generations. During the jury's deliberation, Pietro Ubaldi will hold a talk on dubbing.

The show's host will be Giorgia Vecchini, historic cosplayer and godmother of the contest.

The various prizes up for grabs for those participating in the competition include a PlayStation 5 Pro offered by The King of Games.

#### MONONOKE AND THE LEGEND OF THE YOKAI GIRL

Friday the 25th and Saturday the 26th of April at 11.00, Cinema Visionario

Music, sand, two artists, four hands, a light table and a projector. These are the simple ingredients that combine to create a new kind of engaging and unpredictable show, where spectators are encouraged to lose themselves in their own imaginations, only to then be drawn back into the narrative.

Sand Art is a purely analogical visual language based around invention, refined technique and rhythm. Rhythm that makes light (the light table) and shadow (the sand) bond, fall in love and dominate each other to create unexpected and deeply poetic images.

Using this technique, artists Massimo Racozzi (illustrator and visual designer) and Fabio Babich (cartoonist and painter) perform an original piece created for FEFF27: their interpretation of female *yokai* and how these can call social conventions into question.

Sunday the 27th of April from 12.30 to 16.00, Giardino Loris Fortuna

On the occasion of the Festival, the Giardino Loris Fortuna will be the setting for FEFFNIC, a Japanese-style picnic offering the chance to socialise in the open air. SHI'S restaurant will be offering a special FEFF edition menu for the occasion, inspired by the tradition of the bento, the classic Japanese food box, which will also be available in a kids' version. Bentos can be picked up at the garden upon reservation.

To round out the gastronomic experience, the food box will also include artisanal ice cream from Gelateria Timballo -Fiordilatte, one of our local area's prime delicacies.

Andrea Gulli - Gullidanda - from the Dobialab cultural center will be providing background vibes with a special selection of Asian music from Luk Thung to Khmer Oldies.

#### FEFF KIDS & TEENS

Saturday the 26th and Sunday the 27th of April from 10:00 to 17:00, Giardino Loris Fortuna Project made possible thanks to the contribution of Fondazione Pietro Pittini

The little festival (within the festival) dedicated to children and families returns once again this year with a range of events for learning more about the East. In line with this year's retrospective, the programme takes as inspiration the theme of  $y\bar{o}kai$ , the fascinating creatures of Japanese folklore. Themed workshops and activities will allow participants to discover their secrets through stories, games and artistic workshops.

From this year on there will also be workshops for teenagers who will be able to work alongside professionals to explore illustration techniques, especially those related to the world of manga. The FEFF Village - in the Giardino Loris Fortuna gardens - is a green hub of activities, snacks, games and shows: an opportunity to have a good time and learn more about Asian culture, but also a place to meet up and hang out in full FEFF style.

#### YŌKAI'S CUISINE

Monday the 28th of April at 6.30 pm, Fondazione Friuli

Far East Food brings the authentic flavours of Asia to the Festival through cooking events, tastings and meetings dedicated to Asian gastronomic culture. A journey through tradition and innovation to discover ingredients, techniques and stories related to food.

This year's guests will include Sam Nazionale, known for his blog Pranzo a Konoha, in which he combines traditional Japanese cuisine with the world of anime. During the Festival, he will be offering a cooking demo inspired by this year's retrospective and dedicated to the cuisine of *yōkai*. A journey through flavours and folklore to discover dishes inspired by the legendary creatures of Japan.

#### WELLNESS

Friday the 25th of April and Thursday the 1st of May from 10.00 to 18.00, Giardino Loris Fortuna

For two days, the Giardino Loris Fortuna gardens will be transformed into an oasis of relaxation dedicated to traditional Asian body and mental wellness activities. Under the guidance of various experts, festival-goers will be able to experience a range of relaxing activities such as *Tuinà* massages, Gong Baths and meridian stretching, but above all will have the opportunity to engage with traditional Far Eastern wellness practices.

The Far East Film Festival returns to bring the evening to life with a new format: the Block Party! An experience designed to keep Far Easters entertained from aperitif time until late at night and which will transform three areas of Udine into venues.

Via Asquini/Marinoni, Via Lovaria, Via Sarpi/vicolo Pulesi and Piazza Marconi will come alive with DJ sets and exclusive events that create a vibrant FEFF atmosphere right in the city center. The events scheduled include a date at De Room with GinGin Mezzanotte, a drag queen of Taiwanese origin and protagonist of last year's Pink Night. GinGin will warm up the evening with an irreverent and magnetic show in pure queer cabaret style (9:30 pm) before making way for the DJ set by Libra.

#### PINK NIGHT

Wednesday the 30th of April at 10.00 pm, Casa della Contadinanza

Pink, eros, sexuality: the watchwords of Pink Night! The iconic pink evening of the Far East Film Festival has always been inspired by the Japanese film genre *pinku eiga*, which is characterised by provocative erotic content. Adopting a transfeminist perspective, it questions the representation of bodies, exploring the different facets of eros through talks, performances, installations and DJ sets.

In this edition, vibrant pink energy will be transmitted by Betty Apple, an artist and performer from Taipei who has already captured the attention of Vogue Italia magazine.

An avant-garde artist raised in postcolonial Taiwan, Betty Apple combines music, media art and performance to explore the chaos of the consumerist era. Through erotic objects symbolising kitsch and consumer society, her work challenges aesthetics and conventions using language which is at times grotesque and provocative. She will be the undisputed protagonist of Pink Night, with an eclectic performance followed by a DJ set.

The theme of *pink* will also be explored at other events during the festival: on the 25th of April, musician and DJ Camilla Isola aka millacu will be creating a musical dialogue with Betty Apple's videos at the Teatro Palamostre in the room next to the Contatto bar, in collaboration with Udine Cocktail Week, while on the 29th of April the public will have the opportunity to meet artist Betty Apple and learn more about her work in a talk scheduled at 6:00 p.m at the Galleria Tina Modotti.

#### **CLOSING PARTY**

Friday 2 May at 00.00, Casa della Contadinanza

The FEFF27 closing party will be brought to life by the music of Hiroko Hacci, a Japanese artist based in Milan. A multifaceted and chameleonic artist whose eclectic sound evolves fluidly, transforming the mood wherever she plays, Hiroko is currently resident DJ for Le Cannibale in Milan, and she also performs at music festivals, clubs and private parties around Italy. Her most recent release, Yōkai Parade EP, released on March 14, was born out of a collaboration with Volantis and blends references to ancestral Japanese spirits with contemporary electronic music. Inspired by a psychedelic experience lived in Kobe, where the sound of trains seemed to evoke supernatural presences, this musical journey in four tracks intertwines folklore and modern sounds through enveloping synthesizers and enigmatic vocals.

#### SEXTO MEETS FEFF

At this exclusive preview of Sexto 'Nplugged and the Far East Film Festival, the Teatro San Giorgio in Udine will be hosting a unique and unmissable event: a concert by Mui Zyu - talented singer-songwriter, multi-instrumentalist and producer Eva Liu (vocals, guitar, piano) - who will be joined by musicians Deni Teo, Eloise Macdonald and Luciano Rossi.

British but with Hong Kong origins, Mui Zyu is undoubtedly one of the most interesting emergent voices on the international music scene. With an avant-garde sound that mixes electronic influences, ethereal melodies and references to Chinese traditions, Mui Zyu has won over audiences and critics with her unique and visionary style. Her intimate and poetic lyrics explore themes such as cultural identity, a sense of belonging and the search for oneself, taking listeners on an intense and engaging emotional journey.

Organized by Sexto 'Nplugged, the Far East Film Festival and CSS Teatro stabile di innovazione del Friuli Venezia Giulia – a contemporary creative cultural incubator, which is also hosting a special event this year, the result of a three-way collaboration in the spaces of the Teatro San Giorgio – the event represents an extraordinary joint preview of Sexto 'Nplugged and the Far East Film Festival, two world-class cultural events that combine cinema and music in a highly evocative setting.

Mui Zyu's concert anticipates the rich line-up of Sexto 'Nplugged, which for years has been bringing internationally renowned artists and young talents to the heart of Friuli.

#### SHH... DIAM WILL PUNK YOU!

Saturday the 5th of April at 9:30 pm, Bu.chetto Curated by Pordenone Docs Fest and in collaboration with Bu.chetto

One of the few openly queer bands in Malaysia, Shh... Diam! formed at a pool party in 2009, and have become a symbol of LGBTQ+ struggles in the country. With a punk sound and protest lyrics, the band challenges censorship and denounces discrimination, carrying their message through Asia and beyond.

The band will be in Italy for the first time on the occasion of the screening of the documentary "Queer as Punk" of which they are the stars. Yih Wen Chen's second feature film, "Queer as Punk" had its world premier at the 2025 Berlinale and invites the audience to enter the lives of the band members and the changing political landscape of Malaysia, a country that denies the rights of queer people.

The documentary will be screened on April the 4th at the Cinemazero in Pordenone, on the occasion of Pordenone Docs Fest. The live performance of Shh... Diam will follow on April the 5th at Buchetto (Ud). With their bold sound and contagious energy, Shh... Diam! are guaranteed to shake you up!

#### FECS

Saturday the 26th of April at 6:30 pm, Parco Ardito Desio Curated by Cas\*Aupa and in collaboration with Hybrida and The New Noise

On the occasion of the Far East Film Festival, Cas\*Aupa renews the event dedicated to musical connections with the Far East. The second edition of FECS represents an even deeper immersion in the contemporary sounds of artists whose work creates a bridge between ancestral roots and avant-garde musical languages. This year's international guests will be Mong Tong (live performance) and Dis Fig (DJ Set). Mong Tong is a psychedelic duo from Taipei (Taiwan) who draw inspiration from science fiction, occultism, Taiwanese superstitions and local folklore. The live performance will be followed by a DJ Set from producer, DJ and vocal artist Dis Fig, whose artistic approach is characterised by constant development and experimentation, pushing the boundaries of electronic music towards as yet unexplored territories. Dis Fig's discography boasts two collaborative albums with iconic artists The Bug and The Body.

Local artists - Letargia Morale and No-oN - who take an approach based on the structures and rhythms of Asian music will also be performing.

The event will be rounded off by Hybrida's iconic light show.

Udine Cocktail Week is back with its fourth edition, remaining faithful to its DNA while always attentive to new trends. But while on the one hand it embraces innovation, on the other its vocation for fusion remains strong, thanks to its now consolidated links with the Far East Film Festival.

### GREEN INITIATIVES AT THE FAR EAST FILM FESTIVAL

Sensitivity to environmental issues is one of the FEFF's characteristics. This sensitivity was initially expressed mainly in the cultural sphere through the organisation of meetings and environmental education initiatives for young audiences (this awareness was triggered by the FEFF's ongoing collaboration with ARPAFVG) and the many events characterised by a "green" approach.

The FEFF is n ow taking increasingly committed action to reducing waste, saving energy, using hybrid/electric cars, and encouraging the sustainable mobility of accredited guests and visitors. It privileges digital communication and prints only on certified paper. This year, the festival's classic canvas tote bag is available in a limited edition created from reused street banners and old FEFF bags by **community tailoring shop** *Fîl* of the Udine Caritas. The t-shirts for staff and volunteers and those on sale are made using organic cotton.

Close attention is paid to the **materials used for the staging of the event** and their reuse in subsequent editions, as well as to the issue of waste management. In supplies, even in the food sector, **locally sourced products** are favoured and an increasing amount of space is being given over to vegetarian and vegan options.

From this year on, in addition to Goccia di Carnia water in glass bottles, the FEFF's collaboration with CAFC has led to the creation of three water dispensing points wher e visitors can fill their own bottles and canteens: at the Visionario cinema, at the Teatro Nuovo Giovanni da Udine theatre and at the Giardino Loris Fortuna gardens. This initiative, says CAFC president Salvatore Benigno, "goes beyond the simple gesture of offering drinking water. At a time when there is increasing attention to environmental issues, the installation of water dispensers represents a concrete step towards a more sustainable future because it aims to raise awareness among participants of the importance of reducing plastic consumption and optimising the use of natural resources. Water as symbol of life and sharing," continues the President, "thus becomes a vehicle for a message of ecological responsibility, which integrates perfectly with the mission of the Far East Film Festival to create an environment distinguished by inclusivity and awareness."

For a further leap in quality and a real reduction of its environmental impact, the FEFF has also begun a process of **calculating its carbon footprint.** 

This initiative is being carried out with the support of **TEC4IFVG** and **eFrame** as part of the **Capacity2Transform** European project, which aims at creating innovative green approaches in the creative industries.

In 2024 a large-scale analysis of the carbon footprint of the Far East Film Festival was begun. This effort is part of the broader goal of the **Friuli Venezia Giulia Region** to achieve carbon neutrality by 2045.

With the support of **TEC4IFVG** and **eFrame**, the FEFF is currently working on a roadmap that will help set new standards for the festival industry. This roadmap includes the introduction of innovative pilot actions starting from the 2025 edition of the Festival. These include the implementation of an emissions calculation model based on the data collected, the optimisation of procedures for collecting and managing environmental data, and the development of specific strategies to reduce the ecological footprint, with a particular focus on the logistics and materials sectors.
